Lynnwood fills trail's missing link

Lynnwood officials will celebrate completion of a new pedestrian bridge and connecting trail at 44th Avenue West near Interstate 5 on Wednesday, Aug. 4, at 2 p.m. in the Courtyard Marriott parking lot in Lynnwood.

The \$3.9 million city-funded project completes a missing link in Lynnwood's portion of the Interurban Trail. It is intended to give pedestrians and bicyclists a safer way to cross

44th Avenue West and the southbound I-5 ramp.

The new pedestrian bridge parallels I-5. The western end connects to the trail near the Lynnwood Transit Center. A new 1,500-foot section of trail was built at the east end to connect the bridge to the existing trail at 40th Avenue West.

The city awarded the contract to Allied Construction Associates at the end of 2009. Construction started in January.
